The Municipal Implementation Network

The network will be open to municipalities with plans or interest in implementing programs to install green infrastructure on public and private property to reduce flooding. GCC will facilitate peer-to-peer learning and trainings by experts. Participants will share knowledge, experiences, and lessons learned and benefit from shared training opportunities. Network activities (learning events, webinars, case studies, etc.) will be available to municipalities across Canada. These may include:

- Case studies and lessons learned from incentive, retrofit, and community engagement programs in other municipalities;
- Training/learning events on community engagement and green infrastructure design, construction and maintenance;
- Other activities and resources according to municipal needs.

Participating municipalities are expected to have:

- Interest in adapting areas of repeated flooding to climate change
- Designated person to participate in network activities/meetings
